Deikalion was fishing on a quiet blue sea when he heard the voice of the Goddess Athena. Hurry up, she said, the isle of Issyos has been cursed by the Olympus. And so, fearing for his daughter and only family left, the fisherman sails back to his home, where many dangers are awaiting...

II. OBJECTS AND EQUIPMENT

Deikalion will find stone boxes in his way. Those boxes contain objects that may help him during his quest. Also, there are objects that have been magically hidden all around by Athena, who is secretly supporting him.

Food	eating is the only way to recover your energy
Coins	some money is useful even in this dark moment
Sword	fast but with a short attack range
Spear	slow but with a high attack range
Arrows	manage your arrows carefully, they can save your life
Armor	it reduces the damage taken and blocks small projectiles
Sand clock	a magical object that extends time
Red potion	drink it to extend your energy
Golden Fleece	it grants you a new life after death
Laurel crown	take it as a symbol of victory

There must be a reason for this crazyness, but there's no time to figure it out, the adventure is about to begin...

POLYPHEMUS

Πολύφημος

The son of Poseidon and Thoosa. A giant man-eating cyclop that can throw huge rocks to crush down his enemies. His body is strong enough to survive the wounds produced by swords and spears, but it has a weak point: his only eye.



HYDRA

Υδρα

Guardian of the ancient sunk city. This serpentine monster with many heads will emerge from his cave to spit a boiling acid on her victims, melting them down from their shield to their bones.

MINOTAUR

Μινώταυρος

Abandoned by his father and adopted by Hades. This half man half beast creature has turned into a fierce warrior who finds pleasure in the destruction of villages and cities.



HARPIES

Ἄρπυιες

These bird women haunt the highlands of the mountains. They attack anyone who tries to climb over the rocks.



MEDUSA

Μέδουσα

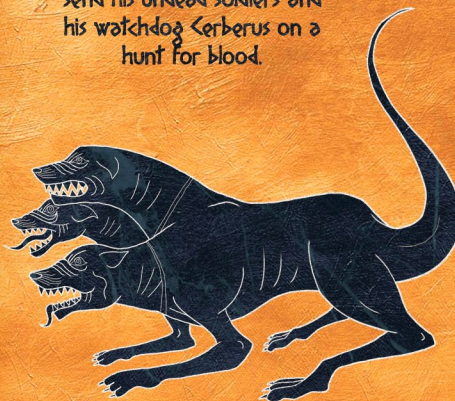
The priestess of Issyos and a talented archer. It's said that she has been turned into a creature so horrible that a single look at her eyes will turn the greatest warrior into cold stone. Brace yourself if you meet her during your quest.



HADES

Ἅδης

Hades enjoys the suffering of mortals, whom he considers unworthy. He is always hungry for souls, and he doesn't hesitate to send his undead soldiers and his watchdog Cerberus on a hunt for blood.



CHARYBDIS

Χάρυβδις

Two sea monsters are waiting in the depths. The menacing Scylla, with her snake like arms, and the furious Charybdis, a titanic octopus demon.
